Public Notice

Adoption of Ordinance 2005-01

**Regulating Peddlers and Solicitors, Requiring Licenses,
Providing a Penalty for Violations Thereof.**

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Credit River, Scott County, Minnesota, now hereby ordains that on, the 1st day of August, 2005, the Credit River Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content, a brief Summary follows:

Division 1	General
Section 1.1:	Definitions – Clarifies language used in the Ordinance
Section 1.2:	Purpose – Identifies purpose of the article as establishing regulations and licensing requirements
Section 1.3:	Exemptions – Describes situations when activities similar to those regulated by this Ordinance are not subject to this Ordinance’s provisions. Specifically excludes some organizations which are registered under Minn. Stat. 309.51 from the provisions of this Ordinance and the procedures these organizations must follow to qualify for an exemption.
Section 1.4:	Duration – Prohibits solicitation during certain hours of the day
Division 2	Restrictions
Section 2.1:	Prohibited practices – Clarifies activities which are not permitted under the terms of the Ordinance.
Section 2.2:	Duties of police – Identifies the procedures a police officer shall take should he/she observe activities which appear to be prohibited by this Ordinance
Section 2.3:	Transient merchants – Clarifies when and where transient merchants are permitted to sell, store and advertise the sale of items
Section 2.4:	Noise – Regulates the types of noise for advertising permitted under this Ordinance
Section 2.5:	Posting of placard prohibiting peddlers, canvassers and solicitors – Describes steps that shall be taken should a resident wish to keep peddles, canvassers and solicitors off his/her property. Provides a penalty should this section be violated.
Division 3	License
Section 3.1	Required – Describes situations when it a license must be obtained in order to sell goods under this Ordinance
Section 3.2	Application – Describes the procedure to apply for a license under this Ordinance
Section 3.3	Restrictions on issuance to transient merchants – Provides restrictions with respect to parking, location and duration of sales by transient merchants
Section 3.4	Fee; term – Provides the fee and term of a license
Section 3.5	Unlawful use – Prohibits use of license by any person other than the person to whom the license was originally issued
Division 4	Revocation of Permit – Describes the situations which the Town Board may revoke a permit issued under this Ordinance. Provides for notice and evaluation procedures should the Town wish to revoke a permit
Division 5	Violation a Misdemeanor – Consequences for violation(s) of this Ordinance is a Misdemeanor as provided under Minn. Statutes
Division 6:	Effective Date – Effective date of Ordinance

The, Ordinance 2005-01 Ordinance Regulating Peddlers and Solicitors, Requiring Licenses, Providing a Penalty for Violations Thereof, shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication.
