Public Notice

Adoption of Ordinance 2005-02

**Regulating Parking on Township Roads and Providing
A Penalty for Violations Thereof.**

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Credit River, Scott County, Minnesota, now hereby ordains that on the 1st day of August, 2005, the Credit River Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content, a brief Summary follows:

- Section 1.00: Definitions – Clarifies language used in the Ordinance
- Section 1.01: Introduction – Identifies locations where parking is prohibited, except in emergency situations
- Section 1.02: Display for Sale – Identifies when vehicles may be parking on any street for the purpose of sale
- Section 1.03: Parking Prohibited – Regulates the parking of vehicles in different zoning districts
- Section 1.04: Commercial Vehicle Parking Prohibited – Regulates parking of commercial vehicles on any public street, avenue, alley or other public way
- Section 1.05: Snow Removal – Describes when vehicles must be removed from public streets, avenues, alleys or other public ways based on snow fall. Absolves the Town from liability due to any damages caused by contracted snow removal operators. Places responsibility on the owners for removal of vehicles from public streets, avenues, alleys or other public ways for failure to remove vehicles as required by this Section
- Section 1.06: Penalty for Violation – Consequences for violation(s) of this Ordinance
- Section 1.07: Severability – Validity of the Ordinance should a provision be declared invalid
- Section 1.08: Effective Date – Effective date of Ordinance
- Section 1.09: Repealer – Repeals “An Ordinance Regulating Parking/and Snow Removal on Credit River Township Roads” dated November 1986

The, Ordinance 2005-02 Regulating Parking on Township Roads and Providing A Penalty for Violations Thereof, shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed during regular Township office hours which are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. An additional copy of the Ordinance will also be on file at the local public library.
